Funds given in honor of National Buzzards Day

(Louisville, KY) March 15, 2021 - In honor of National Buzzards Day on Monday, March 15, the team at Buzzard's Roost Sippin' Whiskeys made a donation to Raptor Rehabilitation of Kentucky to help raise awareness towards Raptor Rehab's work with injured and orphaned birds of prey. The holiday, which started in the Midwest, is a celebration of spring when the buzzards return home, and is a fitting holiday for the whiskey brand which shares the name.

Raptor Rehabilitation of Kentucky, which started in 1990, treats about 300 birds each year with a goal to get most of them healthy enough to go back into the wild. The birds that stay at the facility long-term are there for their own protection. A dedicated volunteer staff and the generosity of supporters help ensure the daily care of the animals. Donated funds go towards food or medical costs, including surgeries, prescriptions, antibiotics, and wound treatments.

"We recently learned that 95% of the injuries inflicted on the birds are the result of human causes such as car accidents, barbed wire fencing, lead poisoning, or even the pesticides used on farmland," said Judith Hollis Jones, Buzzard's Roost President and CEO. "These birds, especially buzzards, are misunderstood creatures who contribute so much to our ecosystem. We're happy to help in some way."
